## Data Review Module (DRM) LEA Data File Layout

The 2009-10 Data Review Module (DRM) online application, developed by Educational Data Systems for the California English Language Development Test (CELDT), assists school districts in making corrections to student demographic data fields within the CELDT student data records. There are two options for making data corrections: (1) online data corrections via data entry screens, and (2) offline data corrections via batch downloadable data files.

This data file layout pertains to the “batch download” option and provides the necessary information for school districts to successfully download student demographic data, correct it on their own systems, and upload it back into the DRM application.

Districts that opt to correct all data online using the DRM application data entry screens need not refer to this layout because the online application provides all of the necessary information needed for editing; however, the information in the “Valid Values” and “Edit” columns of this layout may be helpful while working online.

Further instructions and Frequently Asked Questions on the DRM are contained in the Data Review Module User Guide that is available on the CELDT Web site at [www.celdt.org](http://www.celdt.org).

### ***Downloading and Uploading Files***

The DRM batch download files are available as fixed-width text files (.txt) and as comma-separated value (.csv) files. The fixed-width text files are normally used with mainframe editor programs or statistical package programs. The csv files can be opened in Excel (or other spreadsheet programs) and therefore corrections to data can easily be made in the editable cells. Make sure to maintain the original column order of these files or you will not be able to upload the file back into the DRM application.

Files downloaded as fixed-width text files must be uploaded back into the DRM application as fixed-width text files. The csv files opened in a spreadsheet program must be exported out of the spreadsheet program and saved as a tab-delimited file prior to uploading the file back into the DRM application.

### ***Editing Data***

Certain data fields are editable, while others are not. The “User May Update” column indicates whether the field is editable, i.e., the changes made by the district to the information in the downloaded file will update (override) the existing values in the DRM.

- If the column indicates a “**Yes**,” the district may update the values in this field for any student, whether the field is flagged as an error or not. To ensure that the data you input is valid and will override the data in the DRM, follow the rules contained in the “Valid Values,” “Edits,” and “Edit Rules” columns for each field.
- If the column indicates a “**No**,” the district may not update the values in this field for any student. Information changed in these fields in the downloaded file will be ignored upon upload to the DRM.

### ***Error and Warning Flags***

A “flag” field has been included after each data field that may be edited by the district. The DRM application evaluates the data values according to established edit rules and determines if there are errors or potential errors in the data. If the DRM application detects errors or potential errors in the

data, it adds an error or a warning code in the flag field associated with that data field. The flag codes provide you with information on which data needs correcting.

If the code in the flag field is an “E,” this indicates an “error” in the field; if the code in the flag field is a “W,” this indicates a “warning.” A blank in the flag field indicates no inaccuracies in the data according to the edit rules.

- **Error flags (“E”)** indicate inaccuracies in the data that may impact district accountability, i.e., Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives (AMAOs). In order for the district’s AMAO data to be as accurate as possible, **all errors must be corrected**.
- **Warning flags (“W”)** indicate possible inaccuracies in the data which **should be** reviewed for correction. Correcting data with warning flags will help make school, district, and state summary reports more accurate.

Fields that are not editable (such as Grade Span - Field 28), or are editable but have no edit rules (such as Student ID Number - Field 25), have no flag field or error codes. Note that it is not necessary to remove the flag codes (E and W) from the flag fields prior to upload into the DRM.



### ***Test Purpose Rules***

The Test Purpose, which indicates whether a student is an Initial Identification (II) or an Annual Assessment (AA) student, is important for accountability purposes. If a student has previously been tested with the CELDT (i.e., AA), the most recent previous administration date, the most recent previous scale scores, and the most recent grade for the student are all required to be filled in. (If this information is not available for a student, the data may be left blank.) If a student is being tested for the first time with the CELDT (i.e., II), then these data will not be available and the fields must be left blank.

The following table summarizes the Test Purpose rules and error codes as relates to the previous administration and scores.
