Student Score File Layout – Fixed Width and CSV
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New or Changed for 2009-10

The Student Score File, previously known as a General Research File (GRF), has been modified for 2009-10 to be a shorter, more consolidated file. **The total number of fields included in the file and all field positions have changed from the previous year's layout.** Additionally, many fields have been added and some fields have been deleted to better reflect the data needs of the districts.

Definitions of Technical Terms and Abbreviations

- **CR:** Constructed-Response items where responses are evaluated according to a scoring rubric
- **CSV(Comma Separated Value) File:** a specially formatted plain text file which stores data in a very simple format, with one record on each line, and each field within that record separated by a comma (e.g. Field1, Field2, and so on).
- **DCR:** Dichotomous Constructed-Response items where responses are scored as correct or incorrect
- **Fixed Width Text File:** a file that follows a specific format and that format is specified by the starting position and the column width of the fields in the file
- **GIS:** Group Identification Sheet placed on top of the scannable student documents to identify the school and district for the documents beneath
- **HOSS:** Highest Obtainable Scale Score
- **Lithocode:** a numeric binary code of a unique serial number printed on the bottom margin of the front and back cover of the scannable student documents
- **LOSS:** The Lowest Obtainable Scale Score
- **MC:** Multiple-choice item type
- **NPS:** Non-public school

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Appendix C: Reporting Ethnicity Codes

The Reporting Ethnicity field is created based on the criterion below:

If Hispanic or Latino is “Y”, then Reporting Ethnicity = “500” (Hispanic)

- If Hispanic or Latino is missing or multiple marks then Reporting Ethnicity = “800”.

If Hispanic or Latino is “N” then:

- If no races are selected, then Reporting Ethnicity = “800”.
- If only one race is selected, then set Reporting Ethnicity per Table A.
- If More than one race is selected across multiple major group codes, then Reporting Ethnicity = “800”.
- If more than one race is selected within a major group code, then set Reporting Ethnicity as the major group code plus “00”.
